Biosecurity guidelines

Here are some tips from the show's organizers, to ensure the protection of animal health:

1. Bring on the show only animal in perfect health, and there are no signs of weakness or feeling unwell (apparent weight loss, diarrhea, etc ...)
2. Dewormed your animals regularly. Previously you can administer to your animals a medicine against coccidia 10 days before the show.
3. Clean and disinfect the trailer before the show.
4. Make sure there is straw / bedding in sufficient quantity in the trailer. Especially in case of low temperatures it is especially important that there is a good insulation.
5. To avoid unnecessary stress you can bring your hay, so as not to subject the animals to a change in diet. Of course, we will put at your disposal additional quantity of hay.
6. You can of course also bring with you your water.
7. Cover the floor of the box with straw or hay, to give your animals can lie down warm and dry.
8. Avoid contact with other animals of your specimens.
9. Do not place fans in the paddock.
10. Once back home, separated for some time your animals, so be sure they are healthy.

Our security measures:

- Good health certificate issued by the veterinary surgeon
- The stable has been cleaned and disinfected
- Large ring. Keep your distance from other animals.
- Spot checks by the provincial veterinarian
- Mileage fast to and from the ring to minimize the contact between the animals
- Exclusion of animals suffering from contagious diseases
